

Recording Videos with Zoom

1. Start a Zoom meeting:

- a. Go to Zoom.us and Log in
- b. Choose Host a Meeting – With Video On
- c. Follow the various prompts. You may be asked to download something to your computer.
- d. Join meeting with computer audio

2. Click Record

3. Share your screen

- a. If you don't see the "share screen" button, hover over the bottom of the screen to bring up the tool bar
- b. Click Share Screen
- c. Select the screen you want to display – you can load and share a web page, PPT, Word document, etc; or you can choose the White Board option. After selecting, click the blue "Share screen" button.
- d. The screen you are sharing will be highlighted with a green bar
- e. To stop sharing, hover near the top of the screen, and then click "Stop Share."
 - i. Note that there are other useful features, like "Annotate" available in this tool bar.

4. End the Meeting/Stop Recording

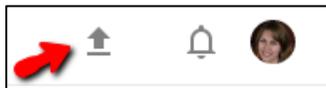
- a. To stop recording, end the meeting by clicking the red "End Meeting" button, then "End meeting for all."
- b. The video will save to your computer in a folder named "Zoom." A subfolder will be created automatically for each meeting you record.
- c. Open the Zoom folder, and locate the MP4Video file. It will be named zoom_0, or something similar.
- d. Upload this file to either Google Drive or YouTube.

- a. Google Drive: Upload the video, and then share with relevant parties

- b. YouTube:

- i. Log into YouTube

- ii. Click the upload button or camera icon in the top right:



- iii. Change public to Unlisted

- iv. Click the big up arrow in the middle of the screen, and use the file picker to select the video

- v. When your video has uploaded, you can share the video with others by copy-pasting the URL.
